State Content Standards for Writing Genres, K-5

Content Standard Writing Genres for Kindergarten:

- -Write words and brief sentences that are legible.
- -Use letters and phonetically spelled words to write about experiences, stories, people, objects, or events.
- -Write consonant-vowel-consonant words (i.e. demonstrate the alphabetic principle).
- -Write by moving from left to right and from top to bottom.

<u>Content Standard Writing Genres for Grade 1</u>:

- -Narratives (fictional, autobiographical) describing an experience
- **-Expository** (descriptions of a real object, person, place, or event, using sensory details)

Content Standard Writing Genres for Grade 2:

- -Narratives (personal experience, sequenced, setting, characters, objects, events in detail)
- -Friendly Letter (date, salutation, body, closing, signature)

<u>Content Standard Writing Genres for Grade 3</u>:

- -Narratives (action, detail, insight)
- **-Descriptions** that use concrete, sensory details to present and support unified impressions of people, places, things, experiences
- -Letters, Thank-you Notes, and Invitations

Content Standard Writing Genres for Grade 4:

- -Narratives (ideas, observations, recollections)
- -Responses to Literature (understanding, judgments)
- -Reports of Information (central question, facts, details)
- -Summaries (main ideas, significant details)

Content Standard Writing Genres for Grade 5:

- -Narratives (plot, point of view, setting, conflict)
- **-Responses to Literature** (understanding of literary work, support judgments, develop interpretations)
- -Research Reports (question, controlling idea, facts, details, examples, explanations)
- **-Persuasive Letters or Compositions** (position, support with evidence, organizational pattern, address reader concerns
